Hilton Québec hotel is proud to be part of the "Green" hotel properties that have instituted programs to save energy and water and reduce solid waste. These earth-friendly initiatives are part of our commitment to reuse, reduce and recycle whenever possible.

These initiatives include:

- Improving operational practices to prevent pollution
- Recycling glass, plastic, metal, cardboard, paper, grease, ink and toner
- Recycling dishes (porcelain and glass)
- Purchasing food from local and regional vendors when possible
- Non-toxic, biodegradable cleaning products
- Fluorescent lighting
- Towel and linen re-use program
- Composting all food waste

Meetings and Banquets:

- Butter: Butter is not served in individual cups but portions in ramekins.
- Milk and cream coffee: individual plastic containers have been replaced by pitchers.
- Water: We prefer water stations (free). Water can also be served in recyclable plastic bottles, only on request (fee).
- The tablecloths and napkins are made of fabric or recycled paper
- Three compartments recycling bins are installed on the floors of meeting rooms and near elevators on each floors. Blue bins are placed in all rooms.
- Notebooks and pens are placed on station in meeting rooms to avoid overconsumption.

Cleaning products:

- Dish Detergent biodegradable (changes had to be made on the machines)
- The laundry done by an outside provider (HMR). The company practices a environmental policy by compliance with, among others, a system wastewater treatment and preferential use of 100% biodegradable products.
